Elementary Divisions	5 th or 6 th grade girls 5 th or 6 th grade boys Each elementary school team is allowed a maximum of 20 players. If a school team has less than 15 players, the coach and school administration may decide to bring up a 4 th grader (ONLY to field a full team). A 4 th grader MAY NOT eliminate a 5 th or 6 th grader.	3 rd /4 th , 5 th /6 th grade girls (4 th -6 th grade girls if not enough players) 3 rd grade boys 4 th grade boys 5 th grade boys 6 th grade boys	5 th /6 th grade girls 5 th /6 th grade boys Due to limited available facilities, there are NO stand-alone 5 th grade teams. If a team has less than (10) 6 th grade players, a 5 th grade player may play on the team. There should be a maximum of (3) 5 th graders and a minimum of (5) 6 th graders. A 5 th grader may MAY NOT eliminate a 6 th grader.
Middle School Divisions	7 th or 8 th grade girls 7 th or 8 th grade boys Each middle school team is allowed a maximum of 30 players.	7 th /8 th grade girls 7 th grade boys 8 th grade boys	7 th /8 th grade girls 7 th grade boys 8 th grade boys
For Both Elementary and Middle schools:	Only one boys' team and one girls' team may be formed for each school. Boys must play on the boys' team and girls' must play on the girls' team. Exception: If a school can field only one team, they may combine boys and girls. That team will play in the boys' division, regardless of the number of boys or girls on the team.	Each school is allowed one team per division. Each team is allowed between 9 - 12 players, with every player required to play one full, uninterrupted quarter each game. Boys must play on the boys' team and girls' must play on the girls' team. Exception: If a school can field only one team, they may combine boys and girls. That team will play in the boys' division, regardless of the number of boys or girls on the team.	Each school is allowed 2 teams per division: an A team and a B team. Each team is allowed between 8 - 10 players, with every player required to play one full, uninterrupted quarter each game. Boys must play on the boys' team and girls' must play on the girls' team. If a school is unable to form a complete girls' team, SoCal Elite is exploring combining schools in order to create girls teams.
