



The Irvine Public Schools Foundation (IPSF) has teamed up with local sports leagues to host the Irvine Youth Sports Tournament of Champions (TOC) during the 2016 - 2017 year.

The Tournament is designed to provide fun opportunities for physical sports education and skill development, promote school spirit in the City of Irvine, and unite the Irvine community in support of healthy lifestyles.

The Tournament of Champions series is comprised of three separate sport tournaments, soccer, flag football, and basketball, and is open to all students in 5th – 8th grades attending elementary and middle schools in the City of Irvine (flag football will also include 3rd and 4th grade divisions). There will be separate boys and girls divisions for each school. The schools are grouped together in five regions and are awarded points after each tournament. At the end of the year, the school with the most points will be presented with the IPSF Tournament of Champions Cup to display at their school.

We ask that the PTA representative:

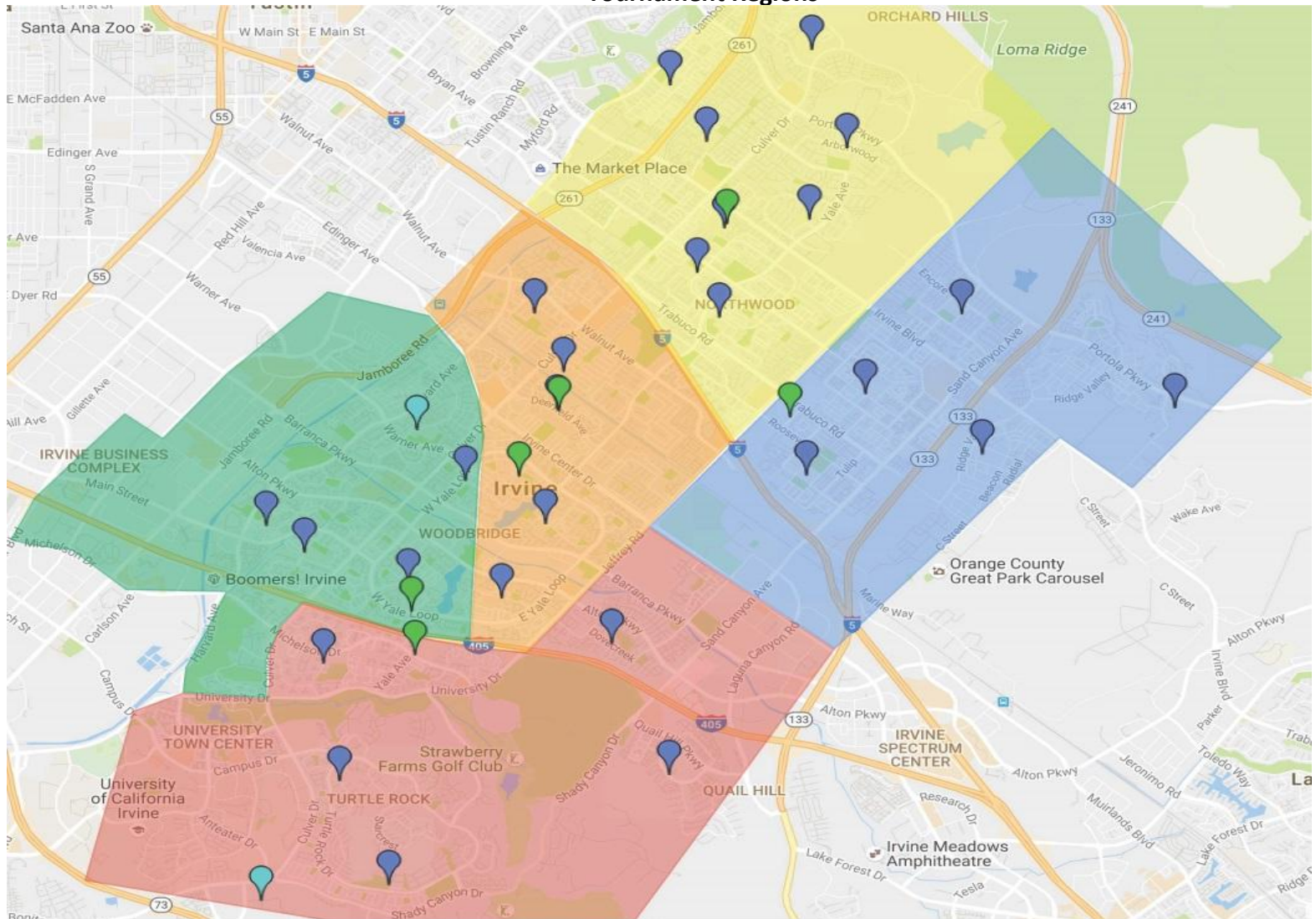
- Act as the conduit of contact between IPSF and the local schools.
- Be the primary means of generating enthusiasm among the students for the tournaments, in conjunction with school staff.
- Help recruit coaches for these school teams.
- Ideally be an overseer for each team at their school, helping, along with each team's coach, to make sure the team is registered on time, parents receive and return consent forms, and that their school's t-shirts are picked up and distributed if the coaches can't.

The program timeline is as follows:

August 29	Registration at school offices begin
September 23	Registration Deadline
October 3	Deadline to register your school's team (player fee of \$25 per student)
October 11	Final roster due to tournament staff. Tournament Brackets drawn randomly (per tournament rules)
October 12	Team uniforms ready for pickup at the IPSF offices located at 1 Post Suite 250, Irvine, CA 92618
October 14/16	Tournament held at various City of Irvine soccer fields and Portola HS
